

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

The school board shall select the date of the annual school election by resolution no later than the first regular meeting after January first of each year. The annual election shall be set between the second Tuesday in April and the third Tuesday in June between the hours of eight o'clock in the morning and seven o'clock in the afternoon on election day.

The school district and the municipality have the option of holding combined school district-municipal election. Subject to approval of the governing bodies, the combined election may be held on the date set by the school district or the general municipal election (second Tuesday in April). Expenses and all other governmental responsibilities of a combined election are to be shared and agreed upon by the governing bodies of the school district and the municipality.
