PUBLIC RECORDS

The Faith School District believes in operating in an open, transparent manner and will make District records available for public inspection, provided the release of the record(s) does not conflict with state or federal law.

The board hereby designates the superintendent or his/her designee as the District's public records officer. The public records officer shall be responsible for allowing inspection of records upon public request, and for maintaining confidentiality of those records not open to the public. The public records officer shall establish a schedule of fees to be charged for the retrieval and copying of public records.
